Summer Programme

Our Summer Programme runs during July and August each year, giving younger learners a complete experience of studying and living in England. The programme is intended for students under the age of 18 and includes tuition, activities, excursions, local transport, and accommodation.

We've put together a complete package that will not only give you a chance to improve your English but will also take you on a tour of the local area and some of the most famous cities in England.

You'll also stay in an English home, which means that you can practise your English in the evenings and at the weekends; you'll also be able to experience English food and weather while you're here - to find out if it's as bad as people say!

Tuition

Classes follow the normal school timetable and according to the normal school levels; from Elementary to Advanced. There is a maximum of 12 students per class and your teachers will be native English speakers, chosen not only for their qualifications but also for their experience and ability to make English language learning fun!

Classes follow our Main Course programme, which means you will study for 15 hours every week - that's 3 hours per day, Monday to Friday.

Accommodation

You will live with carefully selected families who will provide three meals every day and will also look after you well. You can find out more about the accommodation offered by the school on our website.

You will need to take local buses to travel from the accommodation to school but the buses are regular and the journeys are quite short. You'll also need to use the buses for some of the activities and excursions, which is why we include a bus ticket to give you free access to the local buses for your whole stay!



Activities

Weekday afternoons are about relaxing and using your English; our Summer Programme Coordinator will organise various activities that include shopping trips, sports, and trips. You will also have one afternoon excursion every week.

If the weather is bad, or if you don't feel like going out, you can stay at school and use the coffee room, which has internet-ready computers, a TV/DVD, stereo, table tennis, and some board games.

Excursions

Our Summer Programme includes one half-day excursion and one full-day excursion each week. The half-day excursion is an afternoon during the week and typical destinations would be Christchurch, Salisbury, Stonehenge, Winchester, and Poole.

The full-day excursion is taken either on Saturday or Sunday and our most popular destinations are London, Bath, Oxford, and the Jurassic Coast.

Transport

To take part in these activities and excursions, we also include bus tickets that allow you to use the local buses at any time.

This also means that you can use the tickets to travel to and from your homestay accommodation free of charge.

There are a limited number of places on our Summer Programme so we recommend booking early to avoid disappointment. The Summer Programme is a one-price package which includes everything a student needs during their stay.

What's Included

Enrolment, which includes:

All administration, entrance test on first day, all course books, a student card, free internet access at school, and a school diploma on departure.

Tuition Fee, which includes:

15 hours of lessons per week, 9:30am – 12:45pm, Monday – Friday; all lesson materials, including photocopies and use of dictionaries and audio/visual learning aids; all lessons are held by fully-qualified teachers, all native speakers of English.

Accommodation Fee, which includes:

Single Room or Shared Room accommodation as required; full board.

Leisure Programme, which includes:

One full day excursion on the Saturday, one half-day excursion during the week, a tour of Bournemouth on the first Monday morning, activities every other afternoon.

Local Transport, which includes:

Bus tickets to allow free travel in and around Bournemouth. This does not include airport transfers but these can be arranged according to your individual needs.
